Maldon District Council is organising a 'giant fun game that everyone can play'. It involves registering online, downloading a map, picking up a card or a fob and then moving around the routes described on the map, tapping the cards and fobs onto special 'Beat Boxes' arranged around the town. (*Fobs will be made available to children via their schools. Adults can pick up the cards at the event*). Maldon District Council has been funded for this idea through a major grant from Essex County Council's public health programme which aims to improve the health of Essex residents.

Burnham on crouch is launching this event at Riverside Park on **Wednesday 15th May from 3.30pm** for a prompt **4pm start**. The launch will include a couple of short speeches, a light warm up and then a short walk around a couple of the Beat Boxes to explain the process and start the game.
